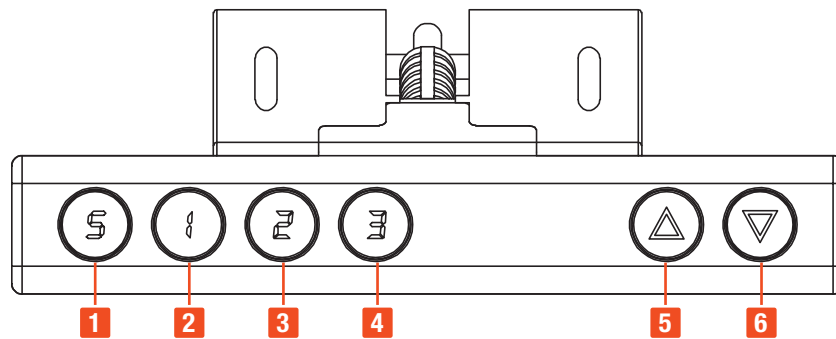

**i Attention!** Before using the device for the first time, the power supply unit must be screwed tightly to the table top.


## OPERATION INSTRUCTION

### OPERATION


When the 'up'  button is pressed, the desk moves up and stops when the button is released.

When the 'down'  button is pressed, the desk moves down and stops when the button is released.



### RESET







The desk must be reset in the following cases:

- Prior to its first use
- If the table is asymmetrical
- If the LED display shows an incorrect reading for the height





Press the down key  until the LED display shows „RES“. The table will return to the lowest displayed height. Release the button to end the reset.

### SAVING HEIGHTS

Using buttons  –  on the control panel, up to three different heights can be saved. The saved height will be retained even if the desk is switched off.



1. Press the 'up'  or 'down'  button to select the desired height.
2. Press the  button; the display will then flash for 5 seconds.
3. Within these 5 seconds, press one of the three memory buttons (,  or .

### RECALL MEMORY POSITION

Press and hold the Up  or Down button  until the desired position is reached or press the Memory buttons ( – ) to automatically move the console to the preset position.

## MENU NAVIGATION




Press and hold the  button for 5 seconds to access the Menu, then press the  button again to view the Menu Guide.

The individual menu items are accessed using the arrow buttons. To go deeper into the menu or to confirm an entry, always press the  button. To exit a menu, press .

## SETTING THE LOWER LIMIT OR UPPER LIMIT




In the menu under „SH“ the lower or upper limit can be set.

- L** - Minimum setting height
- H** - Maximum adjustment height
- 0** - No adjustment made

Use the up  or down key  to set the minimum or maximum height. The setting is completed by pressing the  button again.

## SETTING OF THE HEIGHT INDICATION (CM / INCH)


Press and hold the  button for 5 seconds to access the menu, then press the  button again to view the menu guide.

In the menu field „Un“ the display unit (Si = cm & In = inch) can be changed. You can change the settings using the Up  or Down key . The following is saved by pressing the  button again.

## SETTING THE ANTI-COLLISION SENSITIVITY

The sensitivity can be set in the menu under CF.

- Off** - Function disabled > is not recommended!
- Low** - Sensitivity low
- Normal** - Sensitivity normal
- High** - Sensitivity high

Confirm the setting by pressing the  button.

## SWITCH TONES ON AND OFF

The beep sound can be switched on or off via the menu item bEE. Confirm the entry by pressing the  key.

## DISPLAY BRIGHTNESS

Via „br“ the brightness can be selected between low, normal and high. Confirm the entry by pressing the  key.

## ERRORS & TROUBLESHOOTING

Display	Description	Solution
E02	<b>Blocking protection:</b> In case of unusual movement of the desk (e.g. tilting, collision with other objects or not correct mounting of the power supply unit) the engine stops	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Make sure that the power supply unit is firmly attached to the table top</li> <li>2. Remove the interfering object</li> <li>3. After correcting the error, press any key (except S) to delete the error message and to continue operation</li> </ol>
E10	<b>Motor 1 / motor 2 error</b> The cable from motor 1 / motor 2 is not correctly connected	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Check whether the cable is connected from Motor 1 or 2 properly with is connected to the control box</li> <li>2. Check that the cable from motor 1 or two is unharmed</li> <li>3. Remove the power plug from the socket and plug it in after 20 seconds</li> <li>4. Perform a reset</li> </ol>
E20	<b>Overload of motor 1 or 2</b> Overload, mechanical error	Reduce the weight in order not to exceed the maximum load or to solve the mechanical problem. After 8 seconds, press any button to clear the error message and continue operation or perform a reset
E31	<b>Protection against undervoltage</b> Supply voltage is lower than the limit value	Remove the power cable from the socket and plug it in again after 20 seconds
E32	<b>Protection against overvoltage</b> Supply voltage is higher than the limit value	Remove the power cable from the socket and plug it in again after 20 seconds
E60	The desk does not move up evenly. The two motors are no longer synchronized	The controller must be reset. To do this, please keep the down key pressed until „RES“ (Reset) appears on the screen
HOT	Unit has become too hot	Unplug and wait at least 20 min
